Mathletes, The Mathematics Association, organized three events during Department Week '17. The three events, namely, Just Math, Quant This!, and Make-a-Meme attracted participation from all years, especially from the 2015 and the 2016 batch. "Just Math", an Olympiad style event took place on 16th January, it was primarily based on Proof Oriented questions which tested the analytical skills of the participants as well as their ability to logically derive the required result from a few initial assumptions. The questions were based on topics ranging from Planar and Spatial Geometry to elementary algebra. Simple as the questions seemed, almost all participants solved the papers for the entire duration of the paper (90 minutes).
